SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE JOBS AND EDUCATION PARTNERSHIP REGIONAL BOARD FOR MIAMI-DADE AND MONROE COUNTIES AND THE SOUTH FLORIDA EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING CONSORTIUM FOR FUNDING A SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING PROGRAM, APRIL 1, 1999 - SEPTEMBER 30, 1999

Funding is available from the United States Department of Labor through the State of Florida to Region 23, comprised of Miami-Dade and Monroe Counties, for implementation of the Summer Youth Employment and Training Program (SYETP).

The Division of Schools of Choice submitted a proposal to create 39 Industry Focus Centers to serve a total of up to 1,960 students. The Industry Focus Centers will provide instruction and business-related experience for students, fourteen to twenty-one years of age, during an eight-week summer program. These centers address the goals of SYETP, as well as the *One Community One Goal* initiative.

Twenty-five school sites were identified to be included in the proposal due to their proven track record in offering innovative, rigorous instructional programs and their clear connection with the targeted industries. Students will be enrolled in approximately 180 hours of paid program participation at a rate of \$5.15 per hour. In addition to receiving monetary compensation, students will be enrolled in summer school and will earn an elective high school credit.

Funds, in an amount not to exceed \$1,373,960, have been requested for teacher salaries, hourly personnel, software, supplies, professional and technical services, and field trips. All other operational costs above the Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP) revenues generated by summer school instruction will be covered by SYETP funds. No local funds are required.

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RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the:

1. acceptance of a grant award from and authorization to enter into a contractual agreement with the Jobs and Education Partnership Regional Board for Miami-Dade and Monroe Counties and the South Florida Employment and Training Consortium, in an amount not to exceed \$1,373,960, for funding a Summer Youth Employment and Training Program, April 1, 1999 - September 30, 1999;
2. submission of the above-referenced grant application to other appropriate funding sources as they become available; and
3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
