SUBJECT: TERMINATE AWARD OF BID #195-VV02 – DOORS: WOOD

This bid was awarded by the Board on April 15, 1998, to establish a contract, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of wood doors, for Maintenance Materials Management stock. Items 3 through 10 and 11 through 16, were awarded to Rider Distributors, Inc. of Hialeah, Florida. Subsequent to the award, the awardee failed to deliver the items in accordance with the terms and conditions of the bid. Based on the failure of this vendor to comply with the deliveries, it is recommended that the award of these items be terminated and that the vendor lose eligibility to transact new business with the Board for a period of fourteen (14) months, pursuant to Board Rule 6Gx13- 3C-1.08 – Performance and Payment Security, Declining A Bid Award, And Bonding Company Qualifications. These items will be purchased, as the need arises, utilizing an existing joint bid with Miami-Dade County.
