**SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEE
CURTIS HARRELL - SCHOOL MONITOR
NORTH DADE MIDDLE SCHOOL**

On February 24, 1999, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Mr. Curtis Harrell:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of March 17, 1999, that the School Board suspend you from your current position as School Monitor, North Dade Middle School, for 20 workdays, effective at the close of the workday, March 17, 1999, for just cause, including, but not limited to, Conduct Unbecoming a School Board Employee, and violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties, 6Gx13-5D-1.07, Corporal Punishment Prohibited, and 6Gx13-4-1.08, Violence in the Workplace. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

If you wish to contest your suspension, you must request a hearing in writing within 20 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an administrative law judge.

RECOMMENDED: That effective March 17, 1999, at the close of the workday, the School Board, suspend Mr. Curtis Harrell, School Monitor, North Dade Middle School, for 20 workdays, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
