**SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEE
KENNETH HUMMEL - TEACHER
NORTH DADE MIDDLE SCHOOL**

On February 24, 1999, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Mr. Kenneth Hummel:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of March 17, 1999, that the School Board suspend you for 30 workdays from your current position as teacher, effective at the close of the workday, March 17, 1999, for just cause, including, but not limited to, misconduct in office and conviction of a crime involving moral turpitude, upon such conviction, and violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties, and 6Gx13-5D-1.07, Corporal Punishment-Prohibited. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), 231.36(1)(a), 231.36(6)(a), and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

If you wish to contest your suspension, you must request a hearing in writing within 15 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an administrative law judge.

RECOMMENDED: That effective March 17, 1999, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Mr. Kenneth Hummel, teacher, at North Dade Middle School, for 30 workdays, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
