SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION FOR PAYMENT TO THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE TERMS OF THE SOUTH FLORIDA WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT/U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES PERMIT APPLICATION FOR STATE SCHOOL "JJ"

In order to comply with the terms and conditions of the South Florida Water Management District/U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Environmental Resources Permit application that is required for the construction of State School "JJ", located at NW 50th Street and NW 112th Avenue, the District will be required to deposit the sum of \$170,993.28 in to the Miami-Dade County Mitigation Trust Fund. A portion of the State School "JJ" site is located within the East Turnpike Wetland Basin Jurisdictional Wetland and requires that mitigation be provided for 9.5 acres of impacted wetlands.

Funds for this payment are budgeted in the Capital Outlay Program.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida authorize payment in the amount of \$170,993.28 to Miami-Dade County Department of Environmental Resources Management in compliance with the terms and conditions of the Capital South Florida Water Management District/U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Environmental Resources Permit application for State School "JJ". Funds for this payment are budgeted in the Capital Outlay Program.
