SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD POLICE DEPARTMENT, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$42,075, TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL SECURITY SERVICES AT SOUTH DADE ADULT EDUCATION CENTER, JULY 1, 1999 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2000

South Dade Adult Education Center is proposing utilization of uniformed, off-duty, City of Homestead police officers for security services at the center located at 109 Northeast Eighth Street, Homestead, Florida. Police officers will assist in maintaining a safe learning environment on the days the center is open, Monday through Friday, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., during the period of July 1, 1999 through June 30, 2000.

This security service will operate under a professional services contractual agreement with the City of Homestead Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$42,075. The appropriation will be included in the General Fund of the Tentative Budget to be recommended for adoption July 1999 under Fund 0100, Function 7300, Program 7050, Object 5310, Location 7702. This represents no monetary increase in relation to last year's contract.

The committee established by School Board Rule 6Gx13- 3F-1.02 reviewed this contract on June 3, 1999, and recommended that an exception to the rule governing bids or Request for Proposals be granted as otherwise determined by the committee.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

- 1) authorize the Superintendent to enter into a contractual agreement with the City of Homestead Police Department, in an amount not to exceed \$42,075, to provide professional security services at South Dade Adult Education Center, July 1, 1999 to June 30, 2000; and
- 2) grant an exception to School Board Rule 6Gx13- 3F-1.02.

The appropriation for this item will be included in the General Fund of the Tentative Budget to be recommended for adoption in July 1999.
