SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES, FOR FUNDING THE UNIVERSAL HIRING PROGRAM, MAY 1, 1999 - APRIL 30, 2002

## STRATEGIC PLANNING GOAL: VII - SAFE SCHOOLS

The United States Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS), has approved a grant to the district for funding under the Universal Hiring Program. The COPS Universal Hiring Program is one of several approaches developed by the United States Department of Justice under the Public Safety Partnership and Community Policing Act of 1994. This program is designed to deploy additional officers devoted to community policing on the streets and rural areas of this nation. The program enables agencies to supplement their current sworn forces, or interested jurisdictions to establish a new agency.

The grant award provides a maximum of 75 percent of the approved salaries and benefits for 30 new police officers, with the Federal share decreasing and the local share increasing over the three years. The district is required to provide a 25 percent cost share for the first year.

Although final approval of the budget is pending, it is being recommended that the district be awarded funds in the amount of \$2,250,000 over a three-year period.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept a grant award from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services, in the approximate amount of \$2,250,000, for funding the Universal Hiring Program, May 1, 1999 – April 30, 2002; and
- 2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amount approved by the granting agency, such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
