SUBJECT: THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v. MAE F. BOONE - CASE NO. SUS 98-002 WEISSMAN

On July 8, 1998, the School Board took action to suspend school bus driver Mae F. Boone without pay for thirty (30) days. A hearing was requested and the case was tried on January 13, 1999 before local Hearing Officer David R. Weissman in Miami, Florida.

By recommended order entered May 21, 1999, the Hearing Officer denied the School Board's charge of battery and conduct unbecoming a School Board employee and recommended that the School Board enter a order setting aside Respondent's suspension.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida adopt the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommended Order of the Hearing Officer in Case No. SUS 98-002 Weissman, setting aside the thirty (30) day suspension without pay of Mae F. Boone.
