**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR BOARD APPROVAL TO AMEND MIAMI SHORES/BARRY UNIVERSITY CONNECTED LEARNING COMMUNITY CHARTER SCHOOL, INC., CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT FOR THE 1999-2000 SCHOOL YEAR**

The Miami Shores/Barry University Connected Learning Community Charter School, Inc., has requested that modifications be made to its charter. The Miami Shores/Barry University Connected Learning Community Charter School, Inc., contractual agreement was previously approved by the School Board on July 23, 1997, for a three-year period from July 30, 1997 through June 30, 2000. As per Section 228.056, F.S., a charter school may be modified during its initial term or any renewal term upon the recommendation of the sponsor and the approval of both parties to the agreement. The Miami Shores/Barry University Connected Learning Community Charter School, Inc., has requested that its contractual agreement be amended to include enrollment preference for students residing within four miles of the school, pursuant to Section 228.056, Florida Statutes, as amended during the 1998 legislative session.

A copy of the contractual agreement amendment will be provided to the School Board Members under separate cover, and will be available for inspection by the public in the Office of Board Recording Secretary, and the Citizen Information Center.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve the Miami Shores/Barry University Connected Learning Community Charter School, Inc., contractual agreement, as amended, for the term of the initial contract to provide enrollment preference for students residing within four miles of the school.
