DECEMBER 30, 1999

STRATEGIC PLANNING GOAL: II - STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT/PREPARATION FOR POST-SECONDARY EXPERIENCES

The State of Florida has made available to Miami-Dade County Public Schools the sum of \$270,752 in Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA), Section 123 carryover funds to be used for the enhancement of one-stop centers in Region 23.

In accordance with the requirements of the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) of 1998 and Florida Senate Bill 1566 of 1999, the one-stop centers provide a coordinated service delivery system among the mandated one-stop partners.

The one-stop partners in Region 23 include school systems, community colleges, the WIA Adult and Dislocated Worker Programs, the Florida Department of Labor and Employment Security-Division of Jobs and Benefits Programs, housing authorities, the Job Corps, the Senior Community Service Employment Programs, the Migrant and Seasonal Farmworker Employment and Training Program, Native American employment and training programs, and others.

Each of the one-stop centers in this network will provide core and intensive services, as well as access to Individual Training Accounts that will pay the costs of instruction at the educational institutions. State funding will be expended to provide the resources and equipment needed for these one-stop centers to render the required services to participants.

Funding, in the amount of \$270,752, will cover personnel and equipment.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$270,752, for funding a network of One-Stop Centers, September 1, 1999 – December 30, 1999; and
- 2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
