SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM AND RENEW A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT COUNCIL OF SOUTH FLORIDA TO PROVIDE BASIC SKILLS REMEDIATION AND EMPLOYABILITY SKILLS TRAINING FOR YOUTHFUL OFFENDERS, JULY 1, 1999 – JUNE 30, 2000

STRATEGIC PLANNING GOAL: II - STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT/PREPARATION FOR POST-SECONDARY EXPERIENCES

The Training and Employment Council (TEC) of South Florida has provided \$38,475 under the Job Training Partnership Act, Title II-C, to fund personnel who will provide basic skills remediation and employability skills training for approximately 50 youthful offenders, 14 through 21 years of age, at a location that will offer an optimal teaching-learning environment. Youthful offenders will be recruited through the judicial system. TEC of South Florida will certify eligibility of all participants prior to entry into the program.

Funding and the contractual agreement have been in effect for approximately four years. The renewal of this contractual agreement was approved at the Jobs and Education Partnership/TEC of South Florida Board meeting of July 16, 1999.

Computer technology will be utilized for instructional purposes and to document mastery of competencies. Additional funding will be derived from the full-time equivalency (FTE) generated by enrollment, as well as from the Adult Basic Education grant.

Funding, in the amount of \$38,475, will cover costs for hourly instructional personnel.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from and renew a contractual agreement with the Training and Employment Council of South Florida, in the amount of \$38,475, to provide basic skills remediation and employability skills training for youthful offenders, July 1, 1999 – June 30, 2000; and
2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
