SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE METRO-DADE COUNTY COMMUNITY ACTION AGENCY FOR FUNDING THE HEAD START/PUBLIC SCHOOL TRANSITION PROJECT, AUGUST 1, 1999 – JULY 31, 2000

**STRATEGIC PLANNING GOALS: I - EARLY INTERVENTION
IX - COMMUNITY/HOME/PARENT/SCHOOL/
BUSINESS PARTNERSHIPS**

The Head Start/Public School Transition Project is a collaborative effort between the Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) and the Metro-Dade County Community Action Agency (CAA). The project is designed to develop and coordinate activities to improve the transition of children from Head Start to the school system and to assist families of Head Start children in assessing and participating in classes which address family literacy.

In order to implement the program, the CAA will reimburse the M-DCPS in the amount of \$78,350 for specific program costs. Reimbursable program costs include supplies, materials, contracted services, travel, printing, duplicating, and one-half of the salary and fringe benefits of an Educational Specialist to coordinate the program. The remainder of the salary and fringe benefits will be paid through Prekindergarten Early Intervention funds. In the 1998-99 school year, the M-DCPS received funds in the amount of \$78,350 from the CAA to implement this project.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida authorize the Superintendent to:

1. enter into a cooperative agreement with the Metro-Dade County Community Action Agency, in the amount of \$78,350, for funding the Head Start/Public School Transition Project, August 1, 1999 - July 31, 2000; and
2. renew this agreement, upon mutual agreement, for one additional year, in the amount approved by the funding agency.
