**SUBJECT: DISMISSAL OF EMPLOYEE
JORDAN E. ROGERS - PARAPROFESSIONAL I - THERAPEUTIC
THOMAS JEFFERSON MIDDLE SCHOOL**

On August 16, 1999, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Mr. Jordan E. Rogers:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of August 25, 1999, that the School Board suspend you and initiate dismissal proceedings against you from your current position as Paraprofessional I-Therapeutic, at Thomas Jefferson Middle School effective at the close of the workday, August 25, 1999, for just cause, including, but not limited to, violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Employee Conduct, Conduct Unbecoming a School Board Employee, 6Gx13-4-1.09, Employee-Student Relationships, immorality, misconduct in office, and falsification of employment application. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), 231.3605, and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

If you wish to contest your suspension and dismissal, you must request a hearing in writing within 20 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an administrative law judge.

RECOMMENDED: That effective August 25, 1999, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend and initiate dismissal proceedings against Mr. Jordan E. Rogers, Paraprofessional I-Therapeutic, at Thomas Jefferson Middle School, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
