**SUBJECT: APPOINT AND ASSIGN:

 INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORT (EMERGENCY IMMIGRANT

The following recommendation is made in accordance with Board Rule 6Gx13-4A-1.16.

This open position is a federally funded position.

Ms. Diane Zapata, currently an educational specialist, Division of Bilingual/Foreign Language Skills, is recommended for appointment to the open, budgeted position of District Supervisor, Instructional Support (Emergency Immigrant Education Program), MAPP pay grade 45, Division of Bilingual/Foreign Language Skills. Ms. Zapata received a Bachelor of Science Degree from the University of Puerto Rico, Rio Piedras, Puerto Rico; and, a Master of Science Degree in Education from the University of Miami, Coral Gables, Florida. Since 1983 to the present, Ms. Zapata has been employed by Miami-Dade County Public Schools as a teacher, a technology specialist, and an educational specialist, her current position.

This recommendation is the direct result of the Board-approved advertisement and selection process.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, appoint Ms. Diane Zapata to the open, budgeted position of District Supervisor, Instructional Support (Emergency Immigrant Education Program), MAPP pay grade 45, 12 months, and assign to the Division of Bilingual/Foreign Language Skills, effective August 26, 1999, or as soon thereafter as can be facilitated.
