**SUBJECT: AWARD OF BID #196-XX09 – SANITATION SERVICES AND
CLEANING SUPPLY PROGRAM**

The purpose of this bid, opened on June 22, 1999, is to establish a contract, to purchase, at a firm unit price, quantities, as may be required, of sanitation services and cleaning supplies, for all schools. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price bid, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. Of 298 vendors sent bid forms or card notices of this advertised bid, 28 responded, with 5 bids meeting specifications and 23 no bids.
