**SUBJECT: REQUEST ACCEPTANCE OF THE AD HOC COMMITTEE'S

At the request of the Board, an Ad Hoc Committee met to discuss the feasibility of a student of the year program and ways to reduce out-of-school time for district events. The committee was chaired by Mr. Alex M. Bromir, of the Bureau of Community Services.

Recommendations for the 1999-2000 school year:

- Move the Teacher of the Year to an evening reception;
- Move the Outstanding School Volunteers Awards to a morning reception;
- Move the Dade Partners Exemplary Awards to an after-hours reception (5:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.);
- Combine Office Employee of the Year and Paraprofessional of the Year ceremonies and hold in the evening;
- Combine Assistant Principal of the Year and Principal of the Year into one event and hold in the evening.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, accept the recommendations of the Ad Hoc Committee on District Events for the 1999-2000 school year.
