**SUBJECT: AWARD OF BID #048-ZZ02 - WASTE REMOVAL, HAZARDOUS BIO-MEDICAL MATERIAL (REBID)**

The purpose of this bid, opened on September 9, 1999, is to establish a contract, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of bio-medical hazardous material waste removal, for the Department of Safety, Environmental, and Hazard Management. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price bid, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. Of 58 vendors sent bid forms or card notices of this advertised bid, 10 responded, with 3 bids meeting specifications, 1 non-responsive bid (vendor qualified unit of measure) and 6 no bids.
