SUBJECT: AWARD OF BID #281-XX02 – UNDERGROUND PETROLEUM STORAGE TANKS: REMOVAL AND CLEAN-UP

The purpose of this bid, opened on July 27, 1999, is to establish a contract, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of removal and clean-up of underground storage tanks, for the Department of Safety, Energy, Communication and Fiscal Management. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price bid, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. Of 78 vendors sent bid forms or card notices of this advertised bid, 10 responded, with 5 bids meeting specifications, 1 non-responsive bid (vendor qualified bid with additional cost) and 4 no bids.

The award criterion in the bid indicates that the award be made to a primary and one alternate bidder for items 14 through 17, however, this criterion was not met. Therefore, it is recommended that all bids received for these items be rejected to permit rebidding using revised specifications.
