Authorization is being requested to enter into a contractual agreement with OpSail Miami 2000 to reimburse Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) for substitute costs for participation in the Operation Sail "Beyond the Spectacle" program and the OpSail 2000 Millennium event.

OpSail Miami 2000 is a non-profit corporation with 501c3 status. OpSail Miami 2000 is hosting the millennium voyage of Tall Ships in June 2000. To support this event, the "Beyond the Spectacle" maritime education program is being collaboratively designed by OpSail Miami 2000, the National Maritime Historical Society, Miami-Dade County Public Schools, and other local maritime experts and historians.

Through the "Beyond the Spectacle" program and OpSail Miami 2000 Millennium events, sixth and eighth grade students and teachers in the district will be afforded opportunities to:

- participate in maritime education technology-based programs through Internet links and the development of three education CD-ROMS;
- participate in sail training experiential learning programs, utilizing the American Sail Training Association (ASTA) curriculum aboard the tall ship Heritage of Miami; and

 participate in the OpSail Miami 2000 event, June 6-10, 2000, in which forty students will be selected to participate in an eight day sail aboard a tall ship from San Juan, Puerto Rico to Miami, as 150 tall ships enter the Port of Miami for the millennium event.

Teachers participating in the teacher training institutes will receive curriculum developed to complement the Competency-Based Curriculum (CBC), focusing on maritime history, the impact of Tall Ships on the economy of the United States and Florida, sail training techniques, and team activities. Materials and information will be provided to assist teachers in educating their students about maritime history.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. enter into a contractual agreement with OpSail Miami 2000, in an amount not to exceed \$30,000, for participation in the Operation Sail "Beyond the Spectacle" program and the OpSail 2000 Millennium event, November 1, 1999 June 30, 2000; and
- 2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
