Begun as an annual week-long celebration in 1976, the formal recognition of North American Indians was expanded to a month by Presidential Proclamation in 1990. It was then that November was designated as Native American Heritage Month, a time to celebrate the achievements and contributions of Native Americans. This designation prompts our diverse community to become aware of, recognize and celebrate the many cultural, social, spiritual and economic contributions of American Indians to the United States.
