BUSINESS PARTNERSHIPS

Since 1994, the Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) has received federal, state, and private grants to support the School-To-Work Initiative. This initiative provides for systemic change through a shift from a traditional educational system to a system that combines high-level educational skills and workforce development to prepare all students for continuing education, work, or a combination of both.

During the 1999-2000 school year, the State of Florida awarded continuation funding for the School-To-Work Implementation Program which will provide professional development on the School-To-Work transition process for educators, business members, community leaders, parents, and students. This grant will assist M-DCPS in facilitating community participation in the development of strong school-based and work-based learning activities and will ensure the participation of all students from elementary to senior high school.

The initiative will also help stakeholders establish workplace standards and skills; develop School-To-Work components to be integrated into core curriculum; and engage employers, community partners, and other beneficiaries of Florida workforce development in the academic career preparation of youth.

The grant, in the amount of \$160,000, will cover personnel, pupil transportation, stipends for teachers, materials, and substitute teachers.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$160,000, for funding the School-To-Work Local Implementation Program, October 1, 1999 September 30, 2000; and
- 2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
