SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT GRANT AWARDS ON AN ON-GOING BASIS FROM THE NATIONAL FOUNDATION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF EDUCATION TO IMPROVE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT, SEPTEMBER 15, 1999 – JUNE 30, 2000

**STRATEGIC PLANNING GOALS: II - STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT/PREPARATION FOR POST-SECONDARY EXPERIENCES
III - READING/LANGUAGE ARTS**

Miami Douglas MacArthur South Senior High School has been awarded a grant, in the amount of \$2,500, from the National Foundation for the Improvement of Education. The program is designed to encourage and inspire students to work progressively towards tangible goals. Program objectives will promote artistic expression by combining the talents of at-risk students with the expertise of the professional business world.

The National Foundation for the Improvement of Education awards grants up to \$2,500 each on an on-going basis for a maximum of \$10,000 throughout the school year. Therefore, it is requested that the Superintendent accept awards on an on-going basis through June 30, 2000. All schools were invited to participate in this grant initiative through the Federal Programs and Grants Administration web page.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept grant awards on an on-going basis from the National Foundation for the Improvement of Education, up to \$10,000, to Improve Student Achievement, September 15, 1999 – June 30, 2000; and
2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
