**SUBJECT: RENEWAL OF BID #109-VV02 – FUEL STORAGE TANKS AND MONITORING SYSTEMS: INSPECTION SERVICE AND REPAIR CONTRACT**

The purpose of this bid, opened on October 30, 1997, was to establish a contract, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of fuel storage tank inspection services and repairs, for Maintenance and Operations. The terms of agreement, as contained in the subject bid, awarded by the Board on December 10, 1997, and renewed on December 9, 1998, provided, that by mutual agreement between the successful vendor and The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, the contract may be renewed for two (2) additional one (1) year periods. The contract is currently in its first renewal period. The awardee has agreed to renew for the final one (1) year renewal period, by letter, on file. It is considered to be in the best interest of the Board to renew this bid, for an additional one (1) year period, at the current prices, to benefit from fixed prices during the next twelve (12) months, since the Consumer Price Index (CPI) indicates an increase of 2.1%.
