SUBJECT: TERMINATE AWARD OF ITEMS 20, 71, 72 AND 79 AND RE-AWARD OF ITEMS 71, 72 AND 79 ON BID #003-ZZ03 - FOOD ITEMS: DRY GROCERY

This bid was awarded, by the Board, on July 14, 1999, to establish a contract, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of dry grocery food items, for use in the Food Service Program of the Department of Food and Nutrition.

Item 20, Corn, whole kernel, was awarded to Port Royal Sales, Ltd., of Woodbury, New York. Subsequent to the award of this item, market conditions have changed and the vendor is no longer able to obtain and supply this product at the price bid. These changes, which include price and availability, are at the manufacturers and packers level and were beyond the control of the vendor. The recommendation reflects that the award of this item to Port Royal Sales, Ltd., be terminated and that the Board not implement the prescribed default provision, as noted in Board Rule 6Gx13- 3C-1.08 -- Performance And Payment Security, Declining A Bid Award, and Bonding Company Qualifications, inasmuch as the vendor was not at fault. This item will be purchased, as the need arises, pursuant to Board Rule 6Gx13- 3C-1.10 -- Purchase Approval.

Item 71 – Pudding, chocolate and item 72 – Pudding, vanilla, were awarded to Hopco Food Service, of Tampa, Florida. Subsequent to the award of these items, it was noted that the brand name submitted by another vendor, with a lower unit price, Dulin Food Service, Inc., of Hollywood, Florida, was an approved brand. The recommendation below reflects that the award of these items to Hopco Food Service, be terminated, and the items be re-awarded to Dulin Food Service, Inc., of Hollywood, Florida, the low unit price bidder.

Item 79 – Reduced calories/lite pancakes syrup, was awarded to Mark-Lynn Foods, Inc., of Bremen, Georgia. Subsequent to the award of this item, it was noted that the brand awarded was not an approved brand. The recommendation reflects that the award of this item to Mark-Lynn Foods, Inc., be terminated and the item be reawarded to Dulin Food Service, Inc., of Hollywood, Florida, the lower unit price meeting specifications bidder.
