**SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEE  
CARL SANON - SCHOOL BUS DRIVER  
SOUTH TRANSPORTATION CENTER**

On November 23, 1999, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Mr. Carl Sanon:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of December 8, 1999, that the School Board suspend you from your current position as School Bus Driver, South Transportation Center, for five workdays, effective at the close of the workday, December 8, 1999, for just cause, including, but not limited to, violation of School Board Rule 6Gx13-3E-1.10, Transportation-Specific Procedures, (Safe Driver Plan). This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

If you wish to contest your suspension, you must request a hearing in writing within 20 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an impartial hearing officer.

**RECOMMENDED:** That effective December 8, 1999, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Mr. Carl Sanon, School Bus Driver, at South Transportation Center, for five workdays, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
