**SUBJECT: AWARD OF BID #041-ZZ04 – DISTRICT SOFTWARE LICENSING AND SPECIAL PURCHASING AGREEMENT**

The purpose of this bid, opened on November 2, 1999, is to establish a contract, with a maximum of two (2) vendors as providers/managers of software licensing agreements for comprehensive educational software, to various school locations. The two (2) awarded vendors were selected based on the total low unit prices for specific titles. Quotations will be solicited to the awarded vendors for district volume licenses. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price bid, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. Of 270 vendors sent bid forms or card notices of this advertised bid, 25 responded, with 6 bids meeting specifications (not all vendors bid all items), 5 bids not meeting specifications and 14 no bids.
