SUBJECT: COMPREHENSIVE ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 1999 OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA

STRATEGIC PLANNING GOAL: VIII - PROFESSIONAL STAFF AND PRACTICES

The Comprehensive Annual Financial Report for the Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 1999 of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, which includes audited financial statements, has been received. The school system's external auditors, KPMG LLP, have concluded in their Independent Auditors' Report, that in their opinion, "... the general purpose financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida as of June 30, 1999, and the results of its operations for the year then ended in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles."

In accordance with the procedures for the Office of Management and Compliance Audits, the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report for the Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 1999 of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is submitted to the School Board. The School Board Audit Committee reviewed this report at its November 30, 1999 meeting and will submit its recommendations to the School Board and the Superintendent of Schools by December 6, 1999.

Copies of this report will be distributed to Board Members, the Superintendent of Schools, and appropriate district staff and will be placed on file in the Office of the Recording Secretary to the School Board and in the Citizen Information Center.
