**SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEE
ALLIESTEAN REESE - DATA INPUT SPECIALIST
WILLIAM H. TURNER TECHNICAL ARTS HIGH SCHOOL**

On December 10, 1999, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Ms. Alliestean Reese:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of January 12, 2000, that the School Board suspend you from your current position as a Data Input Specialist at William H. Turner Technical Arts High School for 10 workdays, effective at the close of the workday, January 12, 2000, for just cause, including, but not limited to, violation of School Board Rule 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties, and misconduct in office. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

You have forfeited, in writing, your right to contest your suspension.

RECOMMENDED: That effective January 12, 2000, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Ms. Alliestean Reese, Data Input Specialist at William H. Turner Technical Arts High School for 10 workdays.
