**SUBJECT: AWARD OF BID #080-ZZ07 – GASOLINE - SOUTH OF FLAGLER STREET (TRANSPORT DELIVERY)**

The purpose of this bid, opened on November 9, 1999, is to establish a contract, to purchase, at a firm service charge, with escalation/de-escalation fuel charges based on the Oil Price Information Service (OPIS) average price, quantities, as may be required, of gasoline, for the Department of Transportation. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price bid, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. Of 75 vendors sent bid forms or card notices of this advertised bid, 11 responded, with 8 bids meeting specifications (not all vendors bid all items) and 3 no bids.
