**SUBJECT: APPOINT AND ASSIGN:
PROGRAMMER I, (2)
SYSTEMS AND PROGRAMMING SERVICES**

The following recommendations are made in accordance with the Miami-Dade County Public Schools/Dade County Schools Administrators' Association labor contract.

These open budgeted positions are due to the resignation of one incumbent and the promotion of one incumbent.

Mr. Eduardo Hernandez, currently a Computer Specialist, Records Management, is recommended for appointment to the open, budgeted position of Programmer I, pay grade 33, Systems and Programming Services, Office of Information Technology. Mr. Hernandez received an Associate in Arts Degree in Computer Science from Miami Dade Community College, Miami, Florida. Since 1997 to the present, Mr. Hernandez has been employed by Miami-Dade County Public Schools as a Network Data Communications Specialist and a Computer Specialist, his current position.

Mr. Rafael L. Toll, currently a Computer Specialist, Division of Bilingual/Foreign Language Skills, is recommended for appointment to the open, budgeted position of Programmer I, pay grade 33, Systems and Programming Services, Office of Information Technology. Mr. Toll received a Bachelor's Degree in Electrical Engineering from the Universidad de Oriente, Santiago de Cuba. Since 1992 to the present, Mr. Toll has been employed by Miami-Dade County Public Schools as a teacher and a computer specialist, his current position.

These recommendations are the direct result of the Board-approved advertisement and selection process.
