SUBJECT: RENEWAL OF BID #165-TT02 – WASTE REMOVAL, HAZARDOUS SCHOOL-RELATED MATERIAL

The purpose of this bid, opened on June 3, 1997, was to establish a contract, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of hazardous school-related waste removal, for various locations. The terms of agreement, as contained in the subject bid, awarded by the Board on July 23, 1997, and renewed on July 8, 1998, and June 23, 1999, provided, that by mutual agreement between the successful vendor and The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, the contract may be renewed for three (3) additional one (1) year periods. The contract is currently in its second renewal period. The awardees have agreed to renew for the third one (1) year renewal period, by letter, on file, with the exception of A. R. Paquette and Company, Inc., of Deland, Florida. It is considered to be in the best interest of the Board to renew this bid, for an additional one (1) year period, at the current prices, to benefit from fixed prices during the next twelve (12) months, inasmuch as the Consumer Price Index (CPI) indicates an increase of 2.7%.
