**SUBJECT: AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OPA-LOCKA AND THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF WASTEWATER FACILITIES TO PROVIDE SERVICE TO THE OPA-LOCKA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITE**

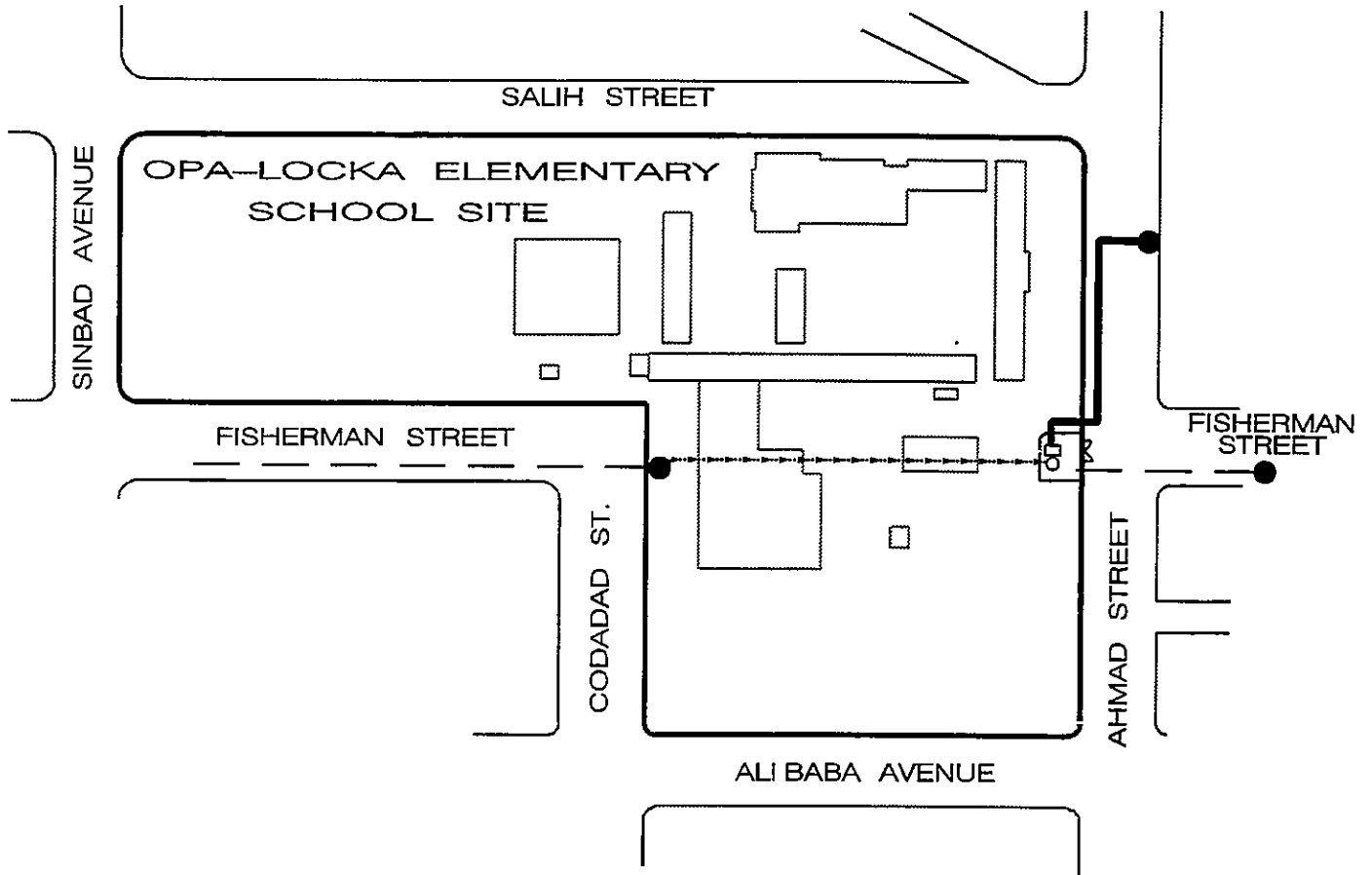
In order to provide wastewater services to the Opa-Locka Elementary School site, the Board abandoned an existing gravity sewer collection system owned by the City of Opa-Locka (City) and installed and connected a pump station and sewer force main and other appurtenances to the existing City of Opa-locka (City) infrastructure (see location map).

The 6.81 acre school site is located at 600 Ahmad Street, Opa-Locka. The Board abandoned an onsite gravity sewer collection system owned and operated by the City in order to construct a new music and classroom addition and a physical education shelter. The City required the Board to build a pump station and force main on Ahmad Street, to redirect the sewage flows so that the nearby residences would not experience a disruption in sewage service. The approximate cost of these wastewater facilities was \$56,500.






The agreement for the wastewater facilities installation has been reviewed and recommended by the Office of Capital Improvements Projects. Public utility facilities constructed on Board-owned property will be conveyed, with appropriate easements to the City of Opa-Locka for future maintenance and operation.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent or his designee to execute an agreement with The City of Opa-Locka and the execution of relevant conveyance documents for the provision of wastewater services for the Opa-Locka Elementary School site at a cost of \$56,500.
