SUBJECT: PROTOTYPE FACILITIES LISTS

On January 14, 1998, the Board approved the District Wide Prototype Facilities Lists, which were based on the 1997 code in effect at that time. Since the approval, The Florida Department of Education has adopted the new code, "State Requirements for Educational Facilities 1999", which went into effect on January 5, 2000.

The following proposed prototypical lists for all district facilities are in compliance with this new code:

- I. Primary Learning Center (280 capacity)
Elementary School (1,045 capacity)
K-8 School (1,434 capacity)
- II. Middle Learning Center (435 capacity)
Middle School (1,346 capacity)
Middle Vocational Select
- III. Senior High School (2,715 capacity)
Senior High Vocational Select
- IV. Full Service (as needed)
- V. Ancillary (i.e. administration, maint., transp., etc.)

These lists have been transmitted to the Board under separate cover and are on file in the Citizen Information Center and the Office of the Board Recording Secretary.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida approve and adopt the proposed prototype facilities lists to be utilized for future facilities.
