SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE BOYS AND GIRLS CLUBS OF MIAMI, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$12,150, TO CONDUCT A SUMMER CAMP FOR CHILDREN FROM THE HOMELESS ASSISTANCE CENTER, FROM JUNE 19, 2000 THROUGH AUGUST 11, 2000

Miami-Dade County Public Schools, through the Miami Skill Center's community school program and in collaboration with the Community Partnership for Homeless, Inc., wants to provide a daylong summer camp through the auspices of The Boys and Girls Clubs of Miami, Inc., 10915 Northwest 14 Avenue, from June 19, 2000 through August 11, 2000. The program will include on-site activities and field trips for 45 Homeless Assistance Center (HAC) children under the supervision of three staff persons. Transportation will be coordinated through the Miami Skill Center in cooperation with staff from the Community Partnership for Homeless, Inc. The Boys and Girls Clubs of Miami, Inc., has conducted this summer camp program for HAC children for the past four years.

The Professional Services Contract Committee established by School Board Rule 6Gx13-3F-1.021 reviewed this contractual agreement on April 26, 2000, and recommended that an exception to the rule be granted as otherwise determined by the committee.

The appropriation for this item is included in the General Fund of the 1999-2000 Adopted Budget under Fund 0100, Function 9100, Program 6500, Object 5150, Location 8991.

Mr. Wayne Blanton is the Executive Director of The Boys and Girls Clubs of Miami, Inc.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

1. authorize the Superintendent to enter into a contractual agreement with The Boys and Girls Clubs of Miami, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$12,150, to conduct a summer camp for children from the Homeless Assistance Center, from June 19, 2000 through August 11, 2000; and
2. grant an exception to School Board Rule 6Gx13- 3F-1.021.

The appropriation for this item is included in the General Fund of the 1999-2000 Adopted Budget.
