**SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEE
JESUS BARRETO - MICROSYSTEMS TECHNICIAN
PAUL BELL MIDDLE SCHOOL**

On May 2, 2000, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Mr. Jesus Barreto:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of May 17, 2000, that the School Board suspend you for 30 calendar days from your current position as Microsystems Technician at Paul Bell Middle School, effective at the close of the workday, May 17, 2000, for just cause, including, but not limited to, misconduct in office, immorality, violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties, and 6Gx13-6A-1.112, Acceptable Use Policy for the Internet. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), 231.3605, and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

You have forfeited, in writing, your right to contest your suspension.

RECOMMENDED: That effective May 17, 2000, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Mr. Jesus Barreto, Microsystems Technician, at Paul Bell Middle School, for 30 calendar days.
