SUBJECT: RENEWAL OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL #248-XX10 – TEENAGE PARENT CHILD-CARE SERVICES FOR CHILDREN WHO MEET LEGISLATIVE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 1999 – 2000 SCHOOL YEAR

The purpose of this Request For Proposal, opened on June 3, 1999, was to establish a contract, at a firm unit price, to provide quality child-care services, for children of pregnant and parenting students seeking a high school diploma, for the Office of Dropout Prevention/Alternative Education. The terms of agreement, as contained in the subject proposal, awarded by the Board on June 23, 1999, provided, that by mutual agreement between the successful vendor and The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, the contract may be renewed for two (2) additional one (1) year periods. The contract is currently in its initial year. The awardee has agreed to renew, for the first one (1) year renewal period, by letter, on file. It is considered to be in the best interest of the Board to renew this proposal, for an additional one (1) year period, at the current prices, to benefit from fixed prices during the next twelve (12) months, inasmuch as the Consumer Price Index (CPI) indicates an increase of 3.7%.
