**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A PERSONNEL ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE DADE PUBLIC EDUCATION FUND FOR THE *FAMILYTECH* PROGRAM**

At the School Board Meeting of October 20, 1999, Agenda Item E-26, the Board authorized a Personnel Assignment Agreement with the Dade Public Education Fund for *FamilyTech*, a program funded by the South Florida Annenberg Challenge, using matching funds from Miami-Dade County Public Schools. Additionally, at the School Board meeting of October 22, 1997, the Board authorized Agenda Item E-3, A Personnel Assignment Agreement with the Dade Public Education Fund for the *FamilyTech* program. The Dade Public Education Fund is the fiscal agent for the *FamilyTech* program.

The primary goal of *FamilyTech* is to ensure that low income public school students and their families acquire the critical technology literacy skills necessary for success in the 21<sup>st</sup> century workplace. Authorization of the Board is requested to enter into a Personnel Assignment Agreement with the Dade Public Education Fund to permit Mr. Morris Gil and Ms. Jennifer Williams to serve as teachers in the *FamilyTech* Program.

This agreement will be effective from August 24, 2000, through June 15, 2001.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to enter into a Personnel Assignment Agreement with the Dade Public Education Fund for:

1. Mr. Morris Gil and Ms. Jennifer Williams for FamilyTech from August 24, 2000, through June 15, 2001; and
2. full reimbursement of salary and fringe benefits to be provided by the Dade Public Education Fund.
