**SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEE  
PETER W. JABLONSKI - TEACHER  
RICHMOND HEIGHTS MIDDLE SCHOOL**

On June 8, 2000, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Mr. Peter W. Jablonski:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of June 21, 2000, that the School Board suspend you, for 30 workdays from your current position as Teacher at Richmond Heights Middle School, effective at the close of the workday, June 21, 2000, for just cause, including, but not limited to misconduct in office, and violation of School Board Rules, 6Gx13-4-1.08, Violence in the Workplace, 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties, and 6Gx13-5D-1.07, Corporal Punishment-Prohibited. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), 231.36, and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

You have forfeited, in writing, your right to contest your suspension.

**RECOMMENDED:** That effective June 21, 2000, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Mr. Peter W. Jablonski, Teacher at Richmond Heights Middle School, for 30 workdays.
