**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT TO  
EXTEND A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE MIAMI-DADE/  
MONROE WAGES COALITION TO PROVIDE INTENSIVE SERVICES  
TO WAGES CUSTOMERS, JULY 1, 2000 – SEPTEMBER 30, 2000**

The Miami-Dade/Monroe Work and Gain Economic Self-sufficiency (WAGES) Coalition awarded a contractual agreement, in an amount not to exceed \$750,000, to the Miami-Dade County Public Schools to provide intensive services to WAGES customers. At the Board Meeting of June 23, 1999, Agenda Item, C-28, the contractual agreement was approved by the Board for the period July 1, 1999 through June 30, 2000. Authorization is requested to extend the contractual agreement through September 30, 2000.

This item does not appear in the published agenda. Notification to extend this contract was received on June 15, 2000. The good cause to vary from the agenda is because the current contract will end on June 30, 2000, and services would not continue beyond this date.

No local funds are required.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to extend a contractual agreement with the Miami-Dade/Monroe WAGES Coalition to provide intensive services to WAGES customers, July 1, 2000 – September 30, 2000.
