**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE SAFE AND DRUG-FREE SCHOOLS PROGRAM, JULY 1, 2000 – JUNE 30, 2001**

The Florida Department of Education has allocated funding to Miami-Dade County Public Schools under the Safe and Drug-Free Schools Program. Funding allocations are based upon districtwide student enrollment.

This grant, in the amount of \$1,629,665, partially funds the To Reach Ultimate Success Together (TRUST) program. Funds will provide salaries for the following: 19 middle school TRUST specialists who provide prevention and intervention services; a Crisis Team psychologist who provides training and consultation in crisis management; two coordinators who provide training and technical assistance to secondary and elementary school teachers, administrators, counselors, and TRUST specialists; two teacher trainers and one educational specialist who provide assistance to the coordinators. Secretarial support, professional development activities, and educational materials are also funded through this program.

No local funds are required.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$1,629,665, for funding under the Safe and Drug-Free Schools Program, July 1, 2000 – June 30, 2001; and
2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
