SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT FUNDS FROM, AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH, THE JOBS AND EDUCATION PARTNERSHIP REGIONAL BOARD AND THE TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT COUNCIL OF SOUTH FLORIDA FOR FUNDING AS A ONE-STOP CENTER OPERATOR AND ELIGIBLE TRAINING PROVIDER, JULY 1, 2000 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2000

The federal Workforce Investment Act (WIA) of 1998 and Chapter 251, Florida Statutes of 1999, require that state and local workforce development efforts be concentrated in the following four strategic areas: (1) Youth Programs, (2) Welfare to Work, (3) High Skills/High Wages, and (4) One-Stop Centers.

The Jobs and Education Partnership (JEP) Regional Board and Training and Employment Council (TEC) of South Florida approved funding for Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) in the amount of \$147,975 will cover partial costs to maintain the existing level of services to One-Stop Centers at Robert Morgan Vocational Technical Institute, The English Center, South Dade Skills Center, Lindsey Hopkins Technical Education Center, and Miami Skill Center. The primary emphasis of the One-Stop Center is to offer employment information, assessment, and job placement for targeted populations including veterans, youth aged 18-21, dislocated workers, individuals with disabilities, and farm workers.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept funds from, and to enter into a contractual agreement with, the Jobs and Education Partnership Regional Board and the Training and Employment Council of South Florida, in the amount of \$147,975, for funding as a One-Stop Center operator and eligible training provider, July 1, 2000 - September 30, 2000; and
2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
