SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING THE INTERGENERATIONAL SERVICE-LEARNING INSTITUTE PROGRAM, REIMBURSABLE COST PERIOD, APRIL 24, 2000 - AUGUST 31, 2000

The Corporation for National Service awards funds as part of the Florida Learn and Serve America Grant Program. The goal of the program is to provide a two-day Intergenerational Service Learning Institute. The purpose of the institute is to introduce and educate teachers, students and community members on ways to initiate intergenerational service-learning programs between schools and community organizations.

Grant funds have been awarded in the total amount of \$11,918 to cover transportation for teachers, students and community members, substitute teacher coverage, supplies, and contracted services.

Official notification relative to this grant award was received on May 23, 2000, which is after the start of the budget period. The budget period for this award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from April 24, 2000.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$11,918, for funding the Intergenerational Service-Learning Institute Program, reimbursable cost period, April 24, 2000 - August 31, 2000; and
2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
