SUBJECT: AWARD OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS #200-ZZ10 – COST RECOVERY AGENT MEDICAID FEE FOR SERVICE PROGRAM JULY 1, 2000 – JUNE 30, 2001 (REBID)

The purpose of this Request For Proposals, opened on April 18, 2000, is to establish a contract, at a firm price, to engage a cost recovery agent, to implement procedures for obtaining reimbursement for services provided to Medicaid eligible students, who are also eligible under the Individual with Disabilities Act (IDEA), for the Office of Exceptional Student Education and Psychological Services. This is a term proposal which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price proposed, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. Of 20 vendors sent proposal forms or card notices of this advertised proposal, 5 responded, with 5 proposals meeting specifications.
