SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT FOR MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO RECEIVE FUNDS, NOT TO EXCEED \$300,000, FROM SOUTH FLORIDA INNER-CITY GAMES FOR FUNDING COMPUTER CAMP ACTIVITIES FROM JULY 1, 2000, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2001.

Authorization is requested for the Superintendent to enter into a contractual agreement for Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) to receive funds, not to exceed \$300,000, from the South Florida Inner-City Games (SFICG) for the purpose of funding staff salaries and fringe benefits for computer camp activities. The locations will be determined by Miami-Dade County Public Schools and the SFICG. The camp will be contingent on the SFICG's receiving funds from WAGES. The camps will serve the children of WAGES clients and others who meet eligibility income requirements set by WAGES.

The camps are designed for middle school students in summer camps with varying beginning and ending dates and in after-school activities during the regular school year. In addition to computer skills education, the camp will provide components in visual and performing arts, sports, self-esteem and anger management. The summer camp students will participate in field trips.

South Florida Inner-City Games will provide a computer consultant; materials, equipment, and supplies; field trip buses and admissions; and visiting visual and performing artists.

The appropriation for this item will be included in the General Fund of the Tentative Budget to be recommended for adoption in July 2000, under Fund 0100, Object 5150 and 5210, location 9619, Program 8945, Function 9105.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to enter into a contractual agreement for Miami-Dade County Public Schools to receive funds, not to exceed \$300,000, from South Florida Inner-City Games from July 1, 2000, through June 30, 2001.

The appropriation for this item will be included in the General Fund of the 2000-01 Tentative Budget to be recommended for adoption in July 2000.
