SUBJECT: PROPOSED PROMULGATION OF NEW BOARD RULE: INITIAL READING 6Gx13- 6A-1.022, EXTENDED YEAR SCHOOL CALENDAR, 2000-2001

This item is submitted for consideration by the Board to establish an extended year school calendar for Opa-locka, Charles R. Drew, Toussaint L'Ouverture, and North Miami elementary schools for the 2000-2001 school year .

The criteria below were considered in developing the calendar:

- ▶ 210 days for K - 5 students
- ▶ 226 days for K - 5 teachers (210 school days for students, ten (10) planning days, and six (6) legal holidays
- ▶ Preschool and postschool planning days

Attached are the Notice of Intended Action and the rule proposed for promulgation.

Authorization of the Board is requested for the Superintendent to initiate rulemaking proceedings in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act for the promulgation of new Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.022, Extended School Year Calendar, 2000-2001, for Opa-locka, Charles R. Drew, Toussaint L'Ouverture, and North Miami elementary schools.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to initiate rulemaking proceedings in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to promulgate new Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.022, Extended Year School Calendar, 2000-2001, for Opa-locka, Charles R. Drew, Toussaint L'Ouverture, and North Miami elementary schools.

NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, announced on June 21, 2000, its intention to promulgate new Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.022, Extended Year School Calendar, 2000-2001, at its Budget Public Hearing meeting of July 24, 2000.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: To establish an extended year (210 days) school calendar for Opa-locka, Charles R. Drew, Toussaint L'Ouverture, and North Miami elementary schools for the 2000-2001 school year.

SUMMARY: Establishes the extended school year calendar for the 2000-2001 school year for Opa-locka, Charles R. Drew, Toussaint L'Ouverture, and North Miami elementary schools, designating days when students and teachers are in school, beginning and ending dates of grading periods, and holidays for students and employees.
