SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS WITH FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$133,032; MIAMI-DADE COMMUNITY COLLEGE, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$37,600; AND ST. THOMAS UNIVERSITY, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$18,500; FOR DUAL ENROLLMENT SERVICES FOR MAGNET PROGRAMS AND SCHOOLS, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$189,132, FROM JULY 20, 2000 THROUGH JUNE 29, 2001

This item is submitted for consideration by the Board for the Superintendent to enter into contractual agreements with Florida International University, in an amount not to exceed \$133,032; Miami-Dade Community College, in an amount not to exceed \$37,600; and St. Thomas University, in an amount not to exceed \$18,500; to offer dual enrollment services for various magnet programs and schools. Magnet programs/schools are unique educational programs operating within the district for which special resources are provided, including dual enrollment/credit opportunities for students at private and public colleges and universities within Miami-Dade County. The proposed dual enrollment services will take place at various magnet and/or college/university locations from July 20, 2000 through June 29, 2001.

The committee established by School Board Rule 6Gx13- 3F-1.021, reviewed the contractual agreements on June 27, 2000, and recommended that an exception to the rule regarding bids or Request for Proposals be granted because the institutions have specific expertise in their respective areas.

Due to the number of programs offered, a summary of dual enrollment services, including costs, is provided on page 3 of 4. The appropriation for this item will be included in the General Fund of the 2000-2001 Tentative Budget to be recommended for adoption in July 2000 under Fund 0100, Object 5310, various locations, magnet programs, Function 5103, for a total amount not to exceed \$189,132. The funding structure for each school is provided on page 4 of 4.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

1. authorize the Superintendent to enter into contractual agreements with Florida International University, in an amount not to exceed \$133,032; Miami-Dade Community College, in an amount not to exceed \$37,600; and St. Thomas University, in an amount not to exceed \$18,500; for dual enrollment services for magnet programs and schools for a total amount not to exceed \$189,132; and
2. grant an exception to School Board Rule 6Gx13- 3F-1.021.

The appropriation for this item will be included in the 2000-2001 General Fund of the Tentative Budget to be recommended for adoption in July 2000.
