**SUBJECT: APPOINT AND ASSIGN:
NETWORK ANALYST I (2)**

The following recommendations are made in accordance with the Miami-Dade County Public Schools/Dade County Schools Administrators' Association labor contract.

These open budgeted positions are due to the conversion of open budgeted positions.

Mr. Garret K. Brown, currently a Communication Support Technician, Network and Internet Services, is recommended for appointment to the open, budgeted position of Network Analyst I, pay grade 41, Procurement and Materials Management. Since 1984 to the present, Mr. Brown has been employed by Miami-Dade County Public Schools as a Skilled Clerical, a Computer Operator, a Network Data Communication Specialist, and a Communication Support Technician, his current position.

Mr. Jose A. Rojo, currently a Communication Analyst I, pay grade 39, Business and Operation Services, is recommended for appointment to the open, budgeted position of Network Analyst I, pay grade 41, Procurement and Materials Management. Mr. Rojo received a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Management Information Systems from Florida International University, Miami, Florida. Since 1996 to the present, Mr. Rojo has been employed by Miami-Dade County Public Schools as a Microsystems Technician, a Network and Data Communication Specialist, a Communication Support Technician, and a Communication Analyst I, his current position.

These recommendations are the direct result of the Board-approved advertisement and selection process.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, appoint:

1. **Mr. Garret K. Brown** to the open, budgeted position of Network Analyst I, pay grade 41, 12 months, and assign to Procurement and Materials Management, effective July 20, 2000, or as soon thereafter as can be facilitated; and
2. **Mr. Jose A. Rojo**, currently a Communication Analyst I, pay grade 39, to the open, budgeted position of Network Analyst I, pay grade 41, 12 months, and assign to Procurement and Materials Management, effective July 20, 2000, or as soon thereafter as can be facilitated.
