**SUBJECT: DISMISSAL OF EMPLOYEE  
WILNER SAINT JUSTE- TEACHER  
HOMESTEAD MIDDLE SCHOOL**

On July 5, 2000, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Mr. Wilner Saint Juste:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of July 19, 2000, that the School Board suspend you and initiate dismissal proceedings against you from your current position as Teacher at Homestead Middle School, effective at the close of the workday, July 19, 2000, for just cause, including, but not limited to, misconduct in office, gross insubordination, and violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties, and 6Gx13-5D-1.07, Corporal Punishment-Prohibited. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), 231.36, and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

If you wish to contest your suspension and dismissal, you must request a hearing in writing within 15 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an administrative law judge.

**RECOMMENDED:** That effective July 19, 2000, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend and initiate dismissal proceedings against Mr. Wilner Saint Juste, Teacher at Homestead Middle School, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
