SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING THE SECOND CHANCE SCHOOLS START-UP GRANT; AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH BAY POINT SCHOOLS, EFFECTIVE AS OF JANUARY 1, 2000 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2000

The Florida Department of Education has advised the Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) of the approval of the Second Chance Start-Up grant entitled Project Bay Point. The project operated and coordinated by Bay Point Schools is designed to improve educational and training programs for adjudicated youth committed to a juvenile facility in Miami-Dade County. The agency head of Bay Point Schools is Dr. Mary Louise Cole.

Funding for the Bay Point Project in the amount of \$100,000 will provide technical assistance and supplies.

Official notification of this grant award was received on June 24, 2000, which is after the effective start date of the grant. The grant award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from January 1, 2000.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$100,000, for funding the Second Chance Schools Start-Up Grant; and enter into a contractual agreement with Bay Point Schools, in the amount of \$100,000, effective as of January 1, 2000 through December 31, 2000;
2. extend this grant award and contractual agreement, for up to one year, at no additional cost, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
