**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING A COLLABORATIVE CURRICULUM PROJECT AT DESIGN AND ARCHITECTURE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL, EFFECTIVE JULY 20, 2000 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2001**

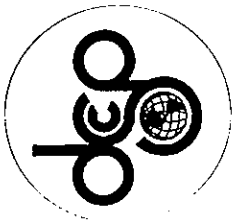
Design and Architecture Senior High School has been awarded a grant from the Florida Department of Education, under the Challenge Grant, Collaborative Curriculum Project. This initiative is designed to improve student academic performance through curriculum development and implementation of redesigned instruction. The goal of this project is to create a seamless interdisciplinary curriculum in art, history, and literature that will engage students in meaningful indepth study.

Schools were invited to apply for this grant opportunity via the Federal Programs and Grants Administration web page. Funds in the amount of \$12,000 will provide audio visual and software materials, supplies and student transportation.

No local funds are required.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$12,000, for funding a Collaborative Curriculum Project at Design and Architecture Senior High School, effective July 20, 2000 through June 30, 2001;
2. extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
